# 1. Matthew 3:7 (KJV)

<sup>7</sup> But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

# 2. Matthew 3:10 (KJV)

<sup>10</sup> And <u>now</u> also the axe <u>is laid</u> unto the root of the trees: therefore every tree which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.

#### 3. Matthew 3:12 (KJV)

<sup>12</sup> Whose fan (*winnowing fork*) *is* in his hand, and he will throughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

# 4. Matthew 10:23 (KJV)

<sup>23</sup> But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, <u>till the Son of man be come</u>.

# 5. Matthew 16:28 (KJV)

<sup>28</sup> Verily I say unto you, There be some standing here, which <u>shall not taste of death</u>, <u>till they see the Son of man coming in his kingdom</u>.

#### 6. Matthew 23:29-36 (KJV)

- <sup>29</sup> Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! because ye build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulchres of the righteous,
- <sup>30</sup> And say, If we had been in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the blood of the prophets.
- <sup>31</sup> Wherefore ye be witnesses unto yourselves, that ye are the children of them which killed the prophets.
- <sup>32</sup> Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers.
- <sup>33</sup> Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?
- <sup>34</sup> Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and *some* of them ye shall kill and crucify; and *some* of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute *them* from city to city:
- <sup>35</sup> That <u>upon you</u> may come all the righteous blood shed upon the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel unto the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar.
